Transrectal Ultrasound of the prostate

Indication: High PSA Prep: Complete Anesthesia: 1 % Lidocaine 10 cc Antibiotic: Cipro

Operative Description: The patient was placed in the left lateral decubitus position. A DRE was done to confirm a complete prep. The bilinear transrectal ultrasound probe was placed in the rectum. Imaging in the transverse and logitudinal planes was obtained. The findings are as follows.
